Jay Mitra is Professor of Business Enterprise and Innovation, Director of The Venture Academy and director of International Development at Essex Business School, University of Essex, UK. He has held similar positions at the Institute of Management Technology in India School of Management, Fudan and Jilin Universities in China, and at Bologna University, Italy. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts in the UK. Jay Mitra also leads the International Entrepreneurship Forum (IEF) a unique network and forum for researchers, policy makers and business practitioners working on entrepreneurship, innovation and regional development. He has written widely on the subjects of entrepreneurship and innovation in refereed journals worldwide and won several best research paper awards in the UK and the USA. His most recent book is 'Entrepreneurship and Knowledge Exchange, (2015) which follows 'Entrepreneurship, Innovation and Economic Development' (2012), both published by Routledge. He has represented his institution as a keynote speaker in distinguished international policy, practitioner and research forums, and has worked with leading agencies such as the OECD, UNCTAD, UNIDO, the EU, and with several government agencies worldwide. He is the editor of the 'Journal of Entrepreneurship and Innovation in Emerging Economies', published by Sage and he sits on the editorial board of various referred international journals. His main research interests are in entrepreneurship and innovation policy, regional development, social and female entrepreneurship, and opportunity development.
